She was Co-Producer, Director, Writer and Camera.

From 2001 Sarah worked in the editing and postproduction area of reality TV gaining a broad range of contacts in the industry. She worked on shows such as "**Big Brother**," "**I'm a Celebrity Get Me Out Of Here**" and "**Missing Persons Unit**" among others.

A change of pace saw her move north to the Tablelands town of Yungaburra, not far from Cairns. She has been working on a multitude of smaller scale projects as well as television documentaries including: "**Chopper Rescue**" Series 1& 2, "**The Lost Years – A Sea Turtle Odyssey**", "**Jenny the Bat Lady**" and "**Mysteries of Shark Coast**"

With a mobile camera kit and edit suite, Sarah has travelled widely through Cape York and the Torres Strait as well as central Australia working for various organisations that required her skills.
